

WindWorks Design Offers Silicone7 Lubricant for Wind Synths

ROCHESTER, NY, 4 September 2001 – WindWorks Design is pleased to offer Silicone7 lubricant for wind controller mouthpieces.

Silicone7 is an industry standard lubricant/watch case sealant. It will not harm wind controller boots/rubbers, won't migrate, harden, or break down. Unaffected by moisture, salts, or mild acids. WindWorks Design has been successfully using this on wind instruments for over four years.

A common problem of wind synth players over the years has been to find an appropriate lubricant to use between the plastic mouthpiece and the rubber moisture boot. Factory supplied cream and cork grease are not working well for many players. Back in 1998, WindWorks Design started using Silicone7 on instruments sent in for repairs.

Our packaging of Silicone7 comes in a 8-gram bottle. Apply it with a small stick like a toothpick. We looked at hypodermic-style applicators, but if you are keeping this in an instrument case, the bottle is less likely to leak.
